

releases must / Vote on list be voted on.




- ✓ Vote on Incubator





So what's the The global poverty gap (in million international-\$) The poverty gap is the amount of money that would be theoretically needed to lift the incomes of all people in extreme poverty




up to the international poverty line of \$1.90 a day. These estimates are expressed in international dollars using 2011 PPP conversion rates. This means that figures account for differences in prices levels, as well as for inflation.




